Special Fishing Regulations for Buffalo Lake: The MN DNR lowered the daily sunfish limit for a number of lakes, including Buffalo Lake, as a part of an initiative to protect and improve the size of sunfish. The new daily limit of sunfish for Buffalo Lake is five.

Officers

President - Presides at all annual, Board and special meetings and shall represent the Association at all official functions. *Vice President Bryan Olschlager will fulfill the President role. See proposed by-law change below.*

Vice President - In the absence of the President, fulfills the duties of the President. Fulfills other duties as designated by the President, the Board or the general membership.

Treasurer - Maintains all revenues and disperses expenditures as designated. Presents a yearly itemized report of income and expense at the annual meeting.

Communications Director - Maintains the website and Facebook page and serves as the editor of the newsletter.

Beach Captains

Beach Captain duties may include the following: Maintain accurate owner database for assigned area and forward contact information to the Association Secretary. Promote membership in lake association. Provide greeting packet for new property owners. Identify items to enhance shoreline life for assigned area.

Proposed By-Law Change

The following proposed change will be discussed and voted on at the annual meeting.

Article V. Section 5. Term of Office

Currently Reads: Officers, including Beach Captains, shall serve a term of three years and shall be elected at the annual meeting by a simple majority.

Recommended Change: Officers, including Beach Captains, shall serve a term of three years and shall be elected at the annual meeting by a simple majority. *The Vice President shall automatically succeed the President and serve a three-year term upon the completion of the President's term.*

4th of July Boat Parade

News from COLA

The most recent COLA meeting was held remotely via Zoom on May 20, 2021. Minnesota Aquatic Invasive Species Research Center (MAISRC) provided an informative presentation giving an update on aquatic invasive species (AIS) and research efforts to control AIS. Spiny water fleas aren't prevalent in a large number of MN lakes at this time, with Lake Mille Lacs being the closest lake; however, there is concern about it potentially being transferred to lakes further northwest. They also discussed research focused on controlling zebra mussels. An experimental copper-based treatment is currently being evaluated and scientists have mapped the genome of the zebra mussel, which they are hopeful will help them learn the best way to control them.

COLA will have new leadership this year. The candidates are as follows: President – David Oberlander (Stakke Lake), Vice President – David Suby (Pickerel Lake), Administrative Assistant – Marilyn Guy (Floyd Lake), and Treasurer – Becky Burns (Buffalo Lake). In addition, COLA will be making some wording changes to their bylaws, primarily to ensure consistent language.
