#### **Small Change Makes a BIG Difference**

We all depend on electricity! It improves our quality of life - from keeping our food safe to lowering and raising our boat lifts to ensure we can cruise around our beautiful lakes! Collectively, we have an opportunity to help improve the quality of life in our community by participating in Operation Roundup. Operation Round Up is a Wild Rice Electric volunteer program where participating members agree to allow the Co-op to round up our monthly bills to the next even dollar. Donation amounts equal approximately \$6 to \$6.50 per year. The money collected is then deposited into a Trust Fund which are then used to provide a benefit to a number of organizations throughout the Wild Rice Electric Cooperative area. The non-profit organizations must apply for the donations.

Since starting the program has made 230 donations totaling \$103,863. Recent contributions were made to Mentor Volunteer Fire & Rescue, Winger Fire & Rescue and Fair Meadows Foundation.

Becker COLA kicked off their 2019 lake season with a near capacity crowd of concerned and motivated Lake Association members on May 23, 2019 at the Richwood Winery. During the meeting the redesigned and much improved COLA website, <a href="beckercola.org">beckercola.org</a> was shown and demonstrated. There is a wealth of information pertinent to any lake user.
